Legal Metrology Oral Examiners' report for September 2022

The Orals

The Orals followed the same format as last year with four test stations set up around the room, each station representing an area of expertise as follows:

- CSMs, tapes (length), beer dispensers
- Water meters, fuel, LPG and road-tankers
- NAWIs and weighing
- AWI weighing, packaged goods

All four stations this session were relatively well answered by candidates with areas of strength being demonstrated in the technical areas of CSMs, tapes (length), beer dispensers and AWI weighing, packaged goods but with some / several candidates lacking knowledge in other areas.

A total of 5 candidates did the Oral in September 2022.

The pass mark for the Oral remains set at 40%. The results for the 2022 Oral examinations are as follows:

W+M Oral: All candidates passed their Oral exams this time.

In the Orals, the lowest mark awarded was 46% and the highest 62%.
